

## Terms of acceptance Out Of Use nv

### What **can** be delivered?

- All electrical and electronic devices that have a plug or work on batteries.
- Both working and non-working devices (protect working devices from damage!).
- Both industrial and household appliances.
- Batteries. (All dry batteries, Li-ion batteries up to a maximum of 330kg)
- Lead-acid batteries. (protect against acid spillage or transport in leakproof container)
- Toner and ink cartridges. (always delivered in a separate box)
- Electric cables and cords.
- Cardboard box for smaller items such as mobile phones, shavers, iPods, PDAs, cameras, batteries, cartridges, hard disks, etc.
- Medical devices, if provided with a certificate of decontamination.

### What **cannot** be delivered?

- Devices containing PCB containing oil.
- Appliances containing oils or fats that could leak during transport (e.g. fryer).
- Devices containing radioactive substances. (e.g. ionic smoke detectors)
- Sharp objects that could injure persons (e.g. knife of an electric kitchen knife).
- Wastes not included in the WEEE category (e.g. residual waste, green waste, PMD, etc).
- Broken glass of devices (e.g. broken glass plate of copier)
- Medical devices of which no decontamination certificate can be provided
- Individual lamps
- Solar Panels

### What is the maximum weight per pallet, roll container or pallet box?

- The total weight in the roll container may never exceed 400 kg.
- The total weight in a pallet box may never exceed 1200 kg.
- The total weight on a pallet may never exceed 1500 kg.

### What if you do not deliver in accordance with the acceptance conditions?

- Any non-conforming delivery will be blocked and not processed further until a solution has been agreed with the customer.
- All shipments may be rejected until such time as they are effectively processed.
- Acceptance on delivery and buffering of your shipment does not mean automatic acceptance of the shipment; final acceptance occurs during processing.
- In general, the customer must retrieve the non-accepted part at his expense.
- All further costs associated with a non-conforming delivery will be charged to the customer. Possible costs may include, but are not limited to: storage, disposal, quarantine, packaging, additional working hours, additional processing costs, etc..
